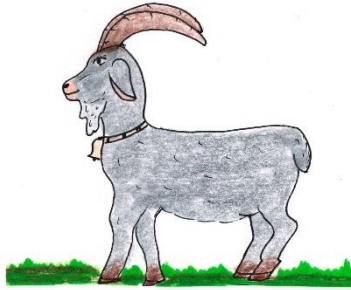

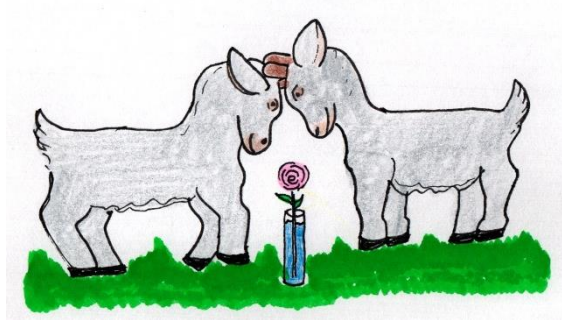
General Requirements:

- Exhibits are entered on Tuesday, July 25th between 4-7 p.m. at the Thurston Expo Center. **All entries in Sections B should be registered with the Youth Entry Chair/Consultant no later than Sunday, July 16th.**
- No pre-registration is needed for Horticulture entries (**Section A**).

General Rules:

- Youth Exhibits are grouped as follows:
 - Junior** - Preschool through age 7
 - Intermediate** - Ages 8 through 12
 - Advanced** - Ages 13 through 18
 - All National Garden Club policies and rules apply.
 - All Horticulture entries must be grown by the exhibitor, although plants can be part of a family garden or yard.
 - Entry cards for Section A will be filled out by the exhibitor in advance. They are available at the Fair Office and from Black Hills District Presidents. A list is available at www.blackhillsdistrict.com/clubs
 - Section B – No artificial plant material allowed. Plant material must be listed on a 3x5 white card. Entry cards for Section B will be done by the Youth Entry Chair/Consultant.

Section "A" Horticulture *"Butting Heads"*



Open to all youth age groups

Horticulture is displaying specimens of annuals, perennials or vegetables.

Class: 14. "Green Fields"

Staged by the show committee in age groups on an 8-foot table.

Notes: a.& b. – Horticulture entries should be placed in water in an appropriate size clear bottle with label removed. Leaves should be removed from the stem that is in the water.

- Flowering annuals** (*annual plants* complete their life cycle within one growing season, typically, from spring to fall)
- Flowering perennials** (plants that persist for many growing seasons; generally, the top portion of the plant dies back each winter and regrows the following spring)
- Garden produce** – Show committee will provide plates to display exhibits.
- Container grown plant material.** Container not to exceed 8 inches in diameter.

Section “B” Design

Open to all youth age groups
Limited to 4 entries for each age group

Floral Design is the art of using plant materials and flowers to create a pleasing and balanced composition.

Class: 15. “The Trolls”

A creative design not to exceed a 12” x 12” space staged by the show committee by age group on an 8’ table.
