**The Washington State Federation of Garden Clubs** is a member of the Pacific Region Garden Clubs (8 western states) and National Garden Clubs, Inc. Globally there are approximately 165,000 members. Each is a designated 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. Your Garden Club members receive benefits from all three.

**Washington State Federation of Garden Clubs** - Benefits include being part of a group of 74 clubs meeting regularly to share their passion for gardening, floral design, continuing education, civic projects and more.

**Grants for Clubs/Districts** – up to \$1,000 per grant, \$10,000 available annually.

**WSFGC Scholarships** Seven, \$2,000 scholarships are given to college students for related educational programs.

**Conventions and Federation Flower Shows**

**Washington State Natural Disaster Fund** – Districts or clubs may request up to \$1,000 per fiscal year for a natural disaster in their area.

**The WSFGC makes Charitable contributions**

to public Washington arboretums/public and botanical gardens/other non-profit organizations with a conservation or environmental focus.
