Class 11. *Crassula* (Perennial Succulents)

Class 12. *Cyclamen purpurascens* (Purple Cyclamen)

Class 13. *Dahlia* Must be disbudded with 1 set of leaves

13a. Giants (over 10”)

13b. Large (8” - 10”)

13c. Medium (6” - 8”)

13d. Small (Under 6”)

Class 14. *Hylotelephium* (Sedums)

Class 15. *Rosa* (Rose)

Class 16. *Rudbeckia* (Black-Eyed Susan)

Class 17. *Solidago* (Goldenrod)

Class 18. Any other worthy named flowering perennial.

Section C: “Take a Tour”

Eligible for NGC Arboreal Award, Award of Horticultural Excellence, WSFGC Marva Lee Peterschick Arboreal Flowering Shrub/Tree Award, WSFGC Betty Belcher Horticulture Award

Flowering Shrubs/Trees (1 branch not less than 12” nor more than 30” in length)

Class 19. *Caryopteris* (Bluebeard)

Class 20. *Hibiscus syriacus* (Rose of Sharon)

Class 21. *Hydrangea quercifolia* (Oakleaf Hydrangea)

Class 22. *Hydrangea paniculata* (Panicked Hydrangea)

Class 23. Any other worthy named flowering shrub/tree.
